Your children are eligible for MA (Medicaid) or CHIP if they are citizens OR if they have any current US immigration document. Your child does not need a social security number to apply.

With health insurance your child can get:

- Doctor visits (including specialists)
- Immunizations
- Eyeglasses
- Dental care
- Medical tests
- Emergency care and hospitalization
- Behavioral health treatment (including Drug & Alcohol help)

What will I need to complete an application?

- Your income for the last 4 weeks such as from employment; unemployment; child support; Social Security Disability; or Supplemental Security Income.
- Any expenses for child care.
- Immigration status such as current VISAs, asylee/refugee papers, stamped passports, or Permanent Residency cards.
- Date of birth for each child applying and their social security number (if they have one.)
- Any other health insurance that covers your child now, or has covered them in the last 3 months.
- Written evaluation, if your child has a disability.
- Unpaid medical bills for your child in the last 3 months, if they are eligible for MA.



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
