Right now, there are about 19,000 children in Pennsylvania who cannot enroll in the state Child Health Insurance Program (CHIP) because they do not have legal immigration status. *The Insure Every Child Campaign* is working towards changing 13 words in state law so all Pennsylvania's children, regardless of their status, can receive quality health care.
