- Most children are poisoned in rental properties by lead-based paint.
- Too many landlords are not complying with the city's lead law which has turned out to be largely unenforceable.
- At the hearing, members of City Council's health committee will hear testimony about a new bill to make the lead law enforceable and help protect our city's children from lead hazards.
