

# Apply for Unemployment Compensation!

Unemployment compensation can put cash in your pocket when you have lost your job through no fault of your own.

**If you are out of work or are losing hours because of the current public health crisis, you should qualify for Pennsylvania Unemployment Compensation.**

**Apply online at [www.uc.pa.gov](http://www.uc.pa.gov) or call the statewide number at 1-888-313-7284.**

Please note, it may be difficult to reach UC by telephone during high volume times.

After you apply for unemployment, every two weeks you must **file a claim** at [www.uc.pa.gov](http://www.uc.pa.gov) or by calling **1-888-255-4728** and

- Report any hours you worked
- Report any PTO you received
- Report any pay you received

We recommend reaching UC with questions using their online chat system at [www.uc.pa.gov](http://www.uc.pa.gov).
