LED A STATEWIDE CAMPAIGN UNITING 11 ORGANIZATIONS across the state dedicated to making early learning investments a priority for Pennsylvania lawmakers.

BUILT PUBLIC PRESSURE with 17 public events generating 20 articles that hit home the need for greater access.

SHOWED LAWMAKERS THEY COULD SOLVE THE PROBLEM through 38 meetings with state lawmakers – connecting them to constituents who made the case for pre-k and child care that serves every Pennsylvania child.

BUILT BIPARTISAN SUPPORT marking the first time ever that the Republican majority party in the state House and Senate passed a budget with more early learning funding than proposed by a Democratic Governor.

A RECORD-BREAKING \$81 MILLION FOR NEW RECURRING FUNDS FOR FREE PRE-K, OPENING THE DOORS OF PRE-K AND HEAD START TO 2,600 MORE CHILDREN.

LED A STATEWIDE CAMPAIGN UNITING 62 ORGANIZATIONS to prevent lead poisoning and ensure children who are exposed to toxic lead get the educational and health care services they need.

BUILT PUBLIC PRESSURE with 15 public events generating 31 news accounts.

SHOWED LAWMAKERS THEY COULD SOLVE THE PROBLEM by meeting with 33 state lawmakers.

GENERATED BIPARTISAN SUPPORT to stop lead poisoning by working with Pennsylvania House Democrats to secure \$10 million for lead paint removal and working with Republican leaders pass a Universal Lead Screening Bill.

LED A POWERFUL COALITION of teachers and experts who paved the way for the passage of historic legislation mandating that Pennsylvania schools use proven methods to do their most basic job – teaching children to read.

SHOWED LAWMAKERS THEY COULD SOLVE THE PROBLEM by holding meetings with every member of the Senate Education Committee to build consensus behind our measure to require the state and colleges to make sure every teacher is prepared to teach reading.

GENERATED BIPARTISAN SUPPORT by partnering with House and Senate Republicans who, together with strong Democratic support, passed one of most ambitious reading instruction reforms in the country.


