
HIGH-QUALITY, PUBLICLY FUNDED PRE-K IN PENNSYLVANIA

In Pennsylvania: 2,997 pre-k locations are eligible** to participate, 2,246 highquality providers participate, and 5,075 additional pre-k classrooms are needed.

* The eligible child count does not reflect the full impact of the COVID-19 pandemic and resulting economic downturn due to the delay in 2020 5-year American Community Survey (ACS) data.

The Pre-K for PA campaign asks state policymakers to support serving an additional 2,308 children and increasing rates for full- and half-day slots necessary to support the early care and education workforce and address rising costs for providers by increasing the high-quality pre-k line items by \$70 million.
